

**CITY OF TALLMADGE
ADULT MEN'S BASKETBALL
LEAGUE RULES
12-20-2009**

The following playing rules will be in effect for the TRC Men's Basketball League. TRC league director reserves the right to amend or add rules during the season as needed. League Director is Randy Keen.

- Games will be played in two (2), twenty (20) minute halves.
- The clock will run continuously except in the last two (2) minutes of each half.
- Overtime – one 2 minute overtime period with each team getting one time out ONLY! If still tied after overtime period game ends in a tie.
- Each team will have two (2) full time-outs per half.
- Players may only be on one roster.
- Time-outs do not carry over to next half.
- Each team will have only one (1) full time-out in overtime period. No timeouts may carry over.
- A team must have four (4) legal players to start and finish a game.
- **ANY PLAYER OR COACH WHO IS EJECTED FROM A GAME WILL LEAVE THE BUILDING AND NOT BE ALLOWED BACK IN FOR THE NEXT 2 SCHEDULED GAMES**
- **DUNKING IS NOT ALLOWED – DURING WARM UP OR GAME SITUATION AND MAY RESULT IN EJECTION FROM GAME. THE DETERMINATION OF THE DUNKING FOUL WILL BE AT THE DISCRETION OF THE OFFICIALS.**
- **Tie breakers: 1) head to head 2) lowest points allowed all games [reward defense] 3) point differential all games, max 15 points per game**
- **All uniforms must be the same color and have a legible number on the back.**
- No chewing gum
- No dew rags or bandanas.
- **All league fees must be paid in full before the season starts or could result in forfeited games**
- Water only on all courts.
- Must clean up bench area of all debris after game and deposit in trash can.
- Zero tolerance for unsportsmanlike conduct.

SUSPENSIONS AND DISCIPLINE PROCEDURES

The Recreation Department offers this league for the benefit and enjoyment of those who participate. Individuals who display poor sportsmanship **are not welcome**. Any player or coach ejected from a game for unsportsmanlike conduct, abusive language, fighting, touching officials or any other reason detrimental to league play, must leave the playing field or facility immediately. Failure to do so may result in his team's forfeiture of the game. Ejected players or coach are automatically suspended from participating in the next 2 scheduled games or longer depending on each individual league rules and may not attend the game. Any player or coach ejected for fighting or any other reason determined by the League Director to be detrimental to the league can be subject to suspension for the remainder of the season or longer.

- All other rules will follow the Ohio High School format.
